Murciano-Granadina

- This is the breed with a clear dairy biotype with uniform black or mahogany colored coat, white coat is not allowed.
- The weight of males ranges from 50 to 70 kg and females from 40 to 55 kg.
- Murciano-Granadina is a dairy breed, but in some cases it is possible to slaughter these animals for meat as well. In this case, young goats, between 35 and 50 days of age, are used.
- The breed is completely oriented to milk production. The average production is more than 700 liters per lactation.
- Murciano-Granadina milk can be used to make delicious hard cheese of the highest quality.
- The growth of Murciano-Granadina young goats can be improved by crossing females of this breed with a male of meat breed.
- The Murciano-Granadina breed is unpretentious in terms of their neighbors. They have a calm temperament and do not fight with each other. For this reason, they can be kept in the same barn with other farm animals.

The Florida Breed

- Very friendly, affectionate animals. They are easy to feed. In Spain they mainly feed on straw, grass and grain mixtures.
- The coat is mottled white on a red background or vice versa, but white speckles on a black background are also allowed (starling).
- Housing systems for this breed range from semi-extreme in mountainous areas to free-stall housing systems, including lowland and rural areas.
- The Florida breed has good immunity and is unpretentious to keep.
- Because of it being taller, the goats have an average birth weight of 3.2 kg and an average daily gain of 180 grams.
- The Florida breed is characterized by a prolificacy of 1.9 in the multiple time lambing and 1.5 in the first time lambing animals, with a natural fertility percentage of 90% in favorable seasons and 70% in unfavorable seasons. The fertility at artificial insemination is 63-65%, which is slightly lower than in other breeds.

The Malagueña Breed

- The Malagueña breed is an indigenous Spanish breed that is among the most dairy breeds in the world. Morphologically, these goats have a uniform light colored coat ranging from light blonde to dark blonde, with a predominance of short wool.
- The weight of the animals ranges from 45 to 60 kg for females and 60 to 75 kg for males. Height at the withers varies from 55 to 70 cm for females and from 65 to 78 cm for males.
- The most important characteristics of this breed are its high milk productivity, both in terms of quantity and quality of milk, as well as its good adaptation to different management systems combined with high endurance.
- The main purpose of the animals is for dairy, at the same time the meat is recognized as a delicacy and served as a fine dish. Dairy goats between 1 month and 6 weeks of age are slaughtered. There is even a patented brand of meat from Malagueña goats.
- The Malagueña breed has one of the highest fertility rates of all breeds, as it remains in the fertile period almost all year round. Its prolificacy is 1.95-2.1. The goats reach 8-9 kg of weight in just 30 days.
